PAPUA NEW GUINEA

Buk Bilong Pikinini

Buk Bilong Pikinini (Books for Children) was set up in Papua New Guinea in 2008 to help improve literacy among PNG's many disadvantaged children through the creation of small libraries in children's hospitals, orphanages, clinics and later in settlements and village schools. Support from individuals and organisations go a long way to help cover the expenses and logistics of running five libraries. This is why Mr David Purcell, CEO of Ela Motors had no hesitation in generously donating a Hiace bus to help transport staff and books to and from the libraries.



Cheshire Homes

Cheshire Homes is Non-Governmental Charity Organization that provides a variety of services for people with various types of disabilities in and around Port Moresby. Matupit Island Community

Matupit Island community is located in the shadow of Mt Tavurvur volcano (East New Britain Province). The community of 2000+ lives in extremely harsh conditions, due to the volcanic activity and resultant ash problems. For eight months of the year, the community is subjected to volcanic ash and sulphur fumes which have major implications for normal living in terms of health, access to fresh water and the like. An approach



was made to Ela Motors to assist in some way to allow the community easier access to the necessities of life. As a result of seeing the conditions in which the community lives, Ela Motors have donated a 23ft boat and 40hp Yamaha engine to this community to the obvious delight of all people living in the area.

Drive TB out of PNG

In Papua New Guinea TB kills more adults than any other infectious disease. Furthermore, about one third of the population is estimated to be infected with latent TB that may later develop into the disease. The World Health Organization (W.H.O) declared TB an emergency public health issue for Papua New Guinea. Ela Motors are a pioneering organisation by actively launching a programme designed to assist in eradicating TB from PNG.

Heart & Kidney Foundation

Fiji has the third highest rate per capita of diabetes in the world – diabetes and hypertension is linked directly to Chronic Renal Failure. However, with the cost of having dialysis overseas being out of reach for the majority of the members of the Fijian community, their choice is limited. The Kidney Foundation of Fiji was presented with a Toyota Yaris from the management & staff of Asco Motors. While accepting the car on behalf of KFOF, founder & chairman of KFOF, Mr. Dewan Maharaj spoke poignantly of the times when he had to sacrifice his personal vehicle to be used in the transporting of patients, medical personnel & supplies. TONGA

It is a non-government organisation and was established by Tonga's Queen Mother with the intention of helping those who need "special care" and are less fortunate. Asco Motors (Tonga) have a monthly donation of fuel for the Center's bus. This bus is the mode of transport for the disabled people who are brought to the Center every morning and returned to their homes in the afternoon. In addition to the fuel donated, Asco Tonga also assists disabled people who have the capacity to learn and work.
